The youth Driver is responsible for driving teens to ensure safe and orderly activities and trips.

Note: The goal is to have enough people to be placed on a roster, so no one person needs to do all the driving.

ANTICIPATED TIME COMMITMENTS

1. **Doing ministry/preparing for ministry:** four hours a month – dependent on roster rotation
2. **Participating in meetings/training:** yearly workshop or upon request

RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

1. Participate in training opportunities yearly, or as presented.
2. Greet teens before activities.
3. Drive teens to predetermined destination
4. Ensure that rules and policies are followed. Be familiar with them ahead of time.
5. Deal with disciplinary problems in a discreet manner. Inform youth pastor of any problems.
6. Pray for wisdom before every event, activity or trip.
7. Pick up and drive home youth for weekly gathering
