

## YOUTH CHAPERONE

The youth chaperone is responsible for supervising and teens to ensure safe and orderly activities and trips. **Note:** The goal is to have enough people participate in this ministry so that each one only has to participate once a month.

### ANTICIPATED TIME COMMITMENTS

1. **Doing ministry/preparing for ministry:** four hours a month – or as needed by event
2. **Participating in meetings/training:** yearly workshop or upon request

### RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

1. Participate in training opportunities yearly, or as presented.
2. Greet teens before activities.
3. Help keep order in the activities.
4. Help supervise teens during trips and special activities.
5. Ensure that rules and policies are followed. Be familiar with them ahead of time.
6. Deal with disciplinary problems in a discreet manner. Call parents if necessary. Inform Community Youth Coordinator of any problems.
7. Pray for wisdom before every event, activity or trip.
